

## **Year 13 Student Assessment Guidance Notes**

Students in Year 13 will have a formal Assessment during the Academic Year along with a Winter Assessment and reported Mock grades.

The definitions used on Assessments by Teachers are listed below.

**Actual Attendance**          Actual Attendance to lessons

**Possible Attendance**      Possible Attendance to lessons

### **Preparedness for Learning**

Excellent	Students always come to lessons fully prepared having read around the lesson topic in advance
Good	Students normally come to lessons prepared having completed all independent study as required
Variable	Students sometimes come to lessons prepared having completed independent study as required
Poor	Students rarely come to lessons prepared

### **Organisation of Written Notes**

Excellent	Students notes are always presented well and filed in a clear and organised manner
Good	Notes are mostly presented well, but improvements could be made in their organisation and storage
Variable	Notes are kept in a secure folder or book but need to be presented in a more coherent form and filed in a more organised manner
Poor	Significant improvements are needed in the presentation, organisation and storage of written notes

### **Progress**

Excellent	Has shown improving levels in every test / assessment / work
Good	Has shown improving levels in most test / assessment / work
Variable	Has made little improvement in the majority of test / assessment / work
Poor	Working well below expected level most of the time

### **Grades**

**Working At Grade** - The level of the present unit of work based upon assessments / several pieces of work.

**Predicted Grade** – The grade that may be attained at the end of the course if the student continues to work at the present level

**Result** – The result of specific assessments undertaken

**Mock Result** – The Mock Exam result achieved
